

CRASH COURSE

Our Crash Courses are interactive two-day workshops designed to give a quick and engaging introduction to the basics.

COURSES

Crash Courses include 4 hours of live instructional where you'll learn essentials like how to introduce yourself, order in a restaurant, request directions, and more.

You should start here if you're an absolute beginner or have taken a decade off.

Level 1 is a 10 session course that meets for 2 hours each week. There are 20 hours of instruction time.

You will learn the basics:

- · How to introduce yourself
- · Talk about your family and closest friends
- Talk about what you normally do on your days off
- · Talk about what your plans for the weekend are
- Describe your likes and dislikes

You should start here if you've already taken level 1 or have studied French before and can comfortably conjugate verbs in the present tense.

Level 2 is a 10 session course that meets for 2 hours each week. There are 20 hours of instruction time.

You should only enter Level 2 if you can confidently answer the following questions:

- · Comment tu t'appelles, et tu es d'où?
- · Comment est ta famille?
- Ou'est-ce que tu fais le week-end?
- · Qu'est-ce que tu vas faire demain?
- Qu'est-ce que tu aimes faire ou manger normalement ?

COURSE OUTLINE

CLASSES	OBJECTIVES
CLASS 1 Introductions	You will be able to read, write, and pronounce French. You will also be able to introduce yourself.
CLASS 2 Descriptions	You will be able to describe what the closest people in your life are like and about French-speaking countries.
CLASS 3 Hobbies	You will be able to describe what you do in your day to day life especially on your days off.
CLASS 4 Directions & Time	You will be able to give and ask for the location of places, tell time, as well as inquire at what time something will take place.
CLASS 5 Family	You will be able to describe your family.
CLASS 6 Plans	You will be able to talk about the places you normally go to as well as talk in the future to make plans with people.
CLASS 7 Foods	You will be able to describe your likes and dislikes and the names of different foods.
CLASS 8 Eating Out	You will be able to order food when dining out.
CLASS 9 Weather & Clothing	You will be able to talk about the weather and clothes.
CLASS 10 Shopping	You will be able to go shopping in French, and give your opinion about different outfits.

COURSE OUTLINE

CLASSES	OBJECTIVES
CLASS 1 The House	You will be able to talk about your household responsibilities. You will also be able to talk about your preferences, obligations and capabilities. You will also learn how to make excuses in French.
CLASS 2 The Bar	You will be able to order drinks at a bar and talk about what you know how to do or people you know. You will also be able to express what you feel like doing.
CLASS 3 Romance	You will be able to use direct object pronouns to not only make your speech sound more fluid and nativelike, but also express your affection to someone, and even ask them out on a date.
CLASS 4 Daily Routine	You will be able to use reflexive verbs to describe your daily routine. You will also learn how to use conjunctive adverbs to connect your phrases and make your speech sound more fluid.
CLASS 5 Works & Communication	You will be able to talk about your profession and describe your work responsibilities. You will also be able to describe your work environment, such as your coworkers and boss.
CLASS 6 Health & Emotions	You will be able to talk about your health and be able to describe common pains and ailments when talking to a doctor in French. You will not only be able to talk about your feelings and emotions, but you will also be able to talk about what bothers or scares you. After this class, you will be able to write posts on social media.
CLASS 7 The Past	You will be able to use the passé composé to begin talking about past events, such as what you did over the weekend.
CLASS 8 Travel	You will be able to use the passé composé to talk about what you did on your last trip or vacation.
CLASS 9 Art	You will be able to use the passé composé to talk about your most recent museum trip, as well as describe your favorite pieces of art.
CLASS 10 Parties	You will be able to use the preterite tense to talk about what you did at your last party. You will also be able to use indirect object pronouns to talk about the gifts you either gave or received.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When do your group courses meet?

We start new group courses on a rolling basis every month! Our online group courses meet for a total of 20 hours of live instruction. We have weekly classes (2 hours once a week for 10 sessions) and biweekly classes (1 hour twice a week for 20 sessions).

What are your refund and cancellation policies?

Plans change-we totally get it. That's why you have until 7 days prior to the start date of your class to make any cancellations or same-level transfers. After that, refunds cannot be offered under any circumstances. (Exception: If you're in an incorrect level placement for a language class, we'll make sure to get you into the right one so long as you let us know prior to the second session of your original course).
