COURSES

Our Crash Courses are interactive two-day workshops designed to give a quick and engaging introduction to the basics.

Crash Courses include 4 hours of live instructional where you'll learn essentials like how to introduce yourself, order in a restaurant, request directions, and more.

You should start here if you're an absolute beginner or have taken a decade off.

Level 1 is a 10 session course that meets for 2 hours each week. There are 20 hours of instruction time.

EVEL 1

You should start here if you've already taken level 1 or have studied Spanish before and can comfortably conjugate verbs in the present tense.

Level 2 is a 10 session course that meets for 2 hours each week. There are 20 hours of instruction time.

You should only enter Level 2 if you can confidently answer the following questions:

- · ¿Qué haces los fines de semana?

CLASSES	OBJECTIVES
CLASS 1 The House	You will be able to talk about your household responsibilities. You will also be able to talk about your preferences, obligations and capabilities. You will also learn how to make excuses in Spanish.
CLASS 2 The Bar	You will be able to order drinks at a bar and talk about what you know how to do or people you know. You will also be able to express what you feel like doing.
CLASS 3 Daily Routine	You will be able to use reflexive verbs to describe your daily routine. You will also learn how to use conjunctive adverbs to connect your phrases and make your speech sound more fluid.
CLASS 4 Health	You will be able to talk about your health and be able to describe common pains and ailments when talking to a doctor in Spanish.
CLASS 5 Emotions	You will be able to talk about your feelings and emotions. You will also be able to talk about what bothers or scares you. After this class, you will be able to write posts on social media.
CLASS 6 Romance	You will be able to use direct object pronouns to not only make your speech sound more fluid and nativelike, but also express your affection to someone, and even ask them out on a date.
CLASS 7 Commands	You will be able to use the imperative to make commands. You will be able to give and ask for directions.
CLASS 8 The Past	You will be able to use the preterite tense to begin talking about past events, such as what you did over the weekend.
CLASS 9 Holidays	You will be able to use the preterite to talk about what you did for some of the major holidays. You will also be able to use reflexive verbs as impersonal verbs to describe what people generally do for each holiday.
CLASS 10 Parties	You will be able to use the preterite tense to talk about what you did at your last party. You will also be able to use indirect object pronouns to talk about the gifts you either gave or received.



When do your group courses meet?
